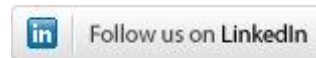

HMRC CRACK DOWN ON TAX EVADERS ON THE INTERNET

HMRC has launched a campaign to crack down on those who evade trade on e-marketplaces such as eBay, Amazon and other retail websites without telling HMRC.

They announced last month that this campaign will be launched over the summer to target companies and individuals who are trading above the £73,000 threshold, but have failed to register for VAT.

The state-of-the-art technology developed by HMRC to co-operate with third party data, to uncover previously hidden anomalies in bank interest, property income and lifestyle indicators. It also features a 'web robot' which enables HMRC to spotlight and identify those who sell goods as trade or business and do not pay tax.

Mike Wells, HMRC's director of Risk and Intelligence, said:

"We will use the information we gather to pursue people who choose not to use the opportunities we provide for them to put their affairs in order on the best possible terms. It will be more expensive if we come and find people, so I urge them to come forward and disclose voluntarily."

To this date, over £500 million has been raised from voluntary disclosures and £100 million from follow-up activity.
